## Attending the service.

- Please arrive at the Centre no more than **10 minutes** before the start of the service. The doors will not be opened until we are ready to begin.
- Whilst outside, please keep **2m distance** from other households.
- Face coverings will normally need to be worn at all times.
- Your attendance will be registered for the purposes of the Governments **Test and Protect** scheme. (According to Data Protection legislation, this information will be kept on record for 28 days before being destroyed).

The services will last around 40 minutes. There will be no singing and we will need to keep 2m between households. While this may all sound very strange we will endeavour to make the experience as safe, as easy and as enjoyable as possible. Most important of all we hope that the opportunity to gather with others to worship together will be an encouraging and uplifting experience and will bring glory to God.
