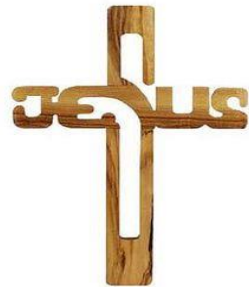


Prayers for Private Use

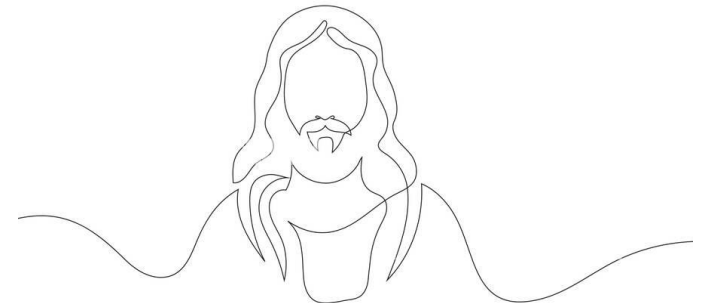
